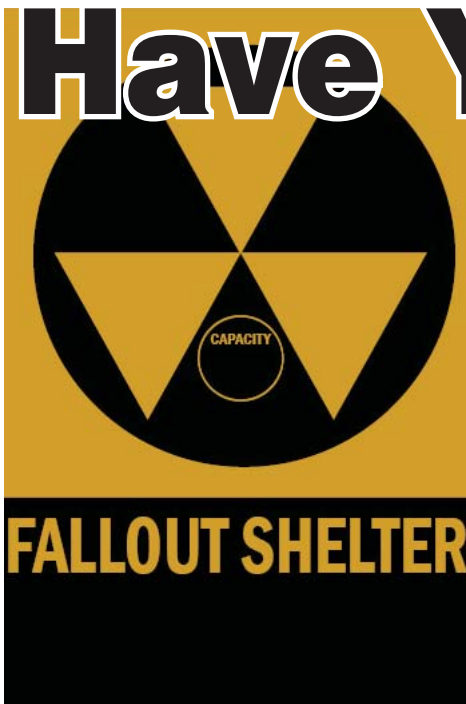


Have You Seen Me?

NYC’s Emergency Management Department released a bizarre 90-second public service announcement on July 11, 2022, about how to react to a nuclear weapons attack. This PSA (pictured right), a throwback to “duck-and-cover” mentality of 60 years ago, implies nuclear war is survivable by going inside, closing windows, showering, and listening to the media for further instructions.



Vestiges of this criminally absurd reasoning are scattered throughout the city

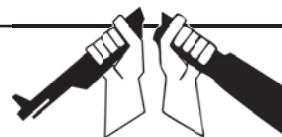
